<u>Contractor/Subcommittee Reports:</u> 2 transducers have been removed from wells. One was recovered onsite, in a nearby cattle trough. Other transducer was taken to Ruidoso and subsequently recovered the following week. Another well has been encroached by tree roots and is no longer able to be monitored. Two of the 14 wells were dry. Edges of basin water levels remain constant and center of basin is seasonably variable by 20 feet, in some places up to 50 feet. USGS is reviving old
